Küchenmonument A social sculpture outside the Berlinische Galerie Dinner, talks and workshops with raumlabor berlin 28.08., 15.09., 17.09. und 02.10.2014

The kitchen is a place for contact and communication. The *Küchenmonument* is a mobile social sculpture that places the kitchen within the public space. After Liverpool, Duisburg, Utrecht and Venice, the "kitchen monument" is coming to Berlin to expand the Berlinische Galerie into its urban surroundings while the building is closed. This inflated translucent room for temporary communities unfolds like a bubble right outside the museum. The Berlinische Galerie is extending an invitation to four events: discussions of current urban issues, a workshop, cocktails, and community cooking.

The *Küchenmonument* project unites raumlabor berlin with plastique fantastique. raumlabor berlin have been practising their combination of art, architecture and urban intervention since 1999. The inflatable mobile structure was first conceived in 2006 and has already been shown in a number of places. It exists in two states: an unassuming zinc-clad box, and a pneumatic spatial mantle which grows out of the sculpture in the form of a bubble. The inside can be designed flexibly. Installing the *Küchenmonument* outside the Berlinische Galerie is also a contribution both to debate about how to use public space in the city and to the museum's interaction with its surroundings.
